In compliance with the provisions of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. Section 1251 et seq. ("the Act") and Pennsylvania's Clean Streams Law, as amended, 35 P.S. Section 691.1 et seq.,

is authorized to discharge from a facility at **624 Center Mills Road, Aspers PA 17304**, located in **Butler Township, Adams County** to **Opossum Creek** in Watershed 7-F in accordance with effluent limitations, monitoring requirements and other conditions set forth in Parts A, B, and C hereof.

The authority granted by this General Permit is subject to the following further qualifications:

1. A Notice of Intent (NOI) is not required for renewal of coverage under this General Permit and coverage is automatically extended for the duration of the final renewed, reissued or amended General Permit. The permittee shall be responsible for complying with the final renewed, reissued or amended General Permit. If the permittee is unable to comply with the renewed, reissued or amended General Permit, the permittee must submit an application for an individual NPDES permit within 90 days of the final General Permit publication.
2. If there is a conflict between the NOI, its supporting documents, and/or amendments and the terms and conditions of this General Permit, the terms and conditions of this General Permit shall apply.
3. Failure to comply with the terms, conditions, or effluent limitations of this General Permit is grounds for enforcement action; for permit termination, revocation and reissuance; or for denial of a permit renewal application.
4. This NPDES General Permit does not constitute authorization to construct or make modifications to Small Flow Treatment Facilities necessary to meet the terms and conditions of this General Permit.

Dear Mr. Longanecker:

Your permit is enclosed. Read the permit and the special conditions carefully.

Please note the expiration date of this General NPDES Permit on page 4. The Department anticipates that the General Permit will be renewed for an additional five-year period before the expiration date. Your coverage under the General NPDES Permit is automatically extended for the duration of the final renewed, reissued, or amended General Permit. Therefore, you do not need to submit a Notice of Intent (NOI) to continue your coverage as long as you remain in compliance with the terms and conditions of the General Permit. One such condition of the General Permit is that you submit complete Annual Maintenance Reports (AMR) to the Department by May 31 each year. If you fail to submit AMRs or do not comply with other conditions of the General Permit, the Department will notify you in writing that you must apply for an individual NPDES Permit.

Pay particular attention to the Maintenance and Self-Monitoring instructions that are given in the Annual Maintenance Report (AMR). The required chlorine residual monitoring must be performed monthly. It requires you to purchase an inexpensive chlorine measuring kit, available at most swimming pool equipment supply distributors. You must also pay attention to any other testing requirements on Page 5 of the permit. These samples must be tested by a water/wastewater testing laboratory. The laboratory results must be submitted along with the AMR to the Department.



Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal, pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. Section 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa. C.S. Chapter 5A, to the Environmental Hearing Board, Second Floor, Rachel Carson State Office Building, 400 Market Street, PO Box 8457, Harrisburg, PA 17105-8457, 717-787-3483. TDD users may contact the Board through the Pennsylvania Relay Service, 800-654-5984. Appeals must be filed with the Environmental Hearing Board within 30 days of receipt of written notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time period. Copies of the appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure may be obtained from the Board. The appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure are also available in braille or on audiotape from the Secretary to the Board at 717-787-3483. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.

IF YOU WANT TO CHALLENGE THIS ACTION, YOUR APPEAL MUST REACH THE BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS. YOU DO NOT NEED A LAWYER TO FILE AN APPEAL WITH THE BOARD.

IMPORTANT LEGAL RIGHTS ARE AT STAKE, HOWEVER, SO YOU SHOULD SHOW THIS DOCUMENT TO A LAWYER AT ONCE. IF YOU CANNOT AFFORD A LAWYER, YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR FREE PRO BONO REPRESENTATION. CALL THE SECRETARY TO THE BOARD (717-787-3483) FOR MORE INFORMATION.
